8. Input Language choose: Chinese (PRC)  
Keyboard layout/IME choose: Chinese Simplified (Microsoft Pinyin IME 3.0)
9. OK
10. Click “EN” icon, you should see “CH(PRC)”

### **For traditional and you want to type in “pinyin”**

1. Start
2. Control Panel
3. Date, Time, Language, and Regional Options
4. Regional Language Options
5. Languages
6. Details
7. Add
8. Input Language choose: **Chinese (Taiwan)**
9. Keyboard layout/IME choose: **New Phonetic**
10. Click New Phonetic and check right side click “**properties**”
11. Click “keyboard” and choose “**Hanyu Pinyin**”
12. Click ok
13. Click “EN” icon, you should see “**CH(Taiwan)**”
